The Train Gourmand du Vignoble is the first inter-village train to explore the Alsace vineyard panoramas.

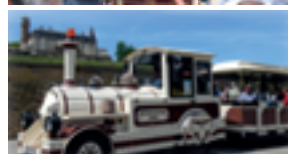
The aim is to allow visitors to enjoy our wonderful terroir and heritage through ample walks combining leisure and serenity.

Five Gourmet Senses

The indulgence of the Train Gourmand du Vignoble is what authorises our five senses to come alive.

1. Our **sight**, for looking-over and contemplating the deliciously-appealing landscape.
2. Our **hearing**, for the silence, the rustling of leaves, the wind blowing... for us to listen to.
3. Our **smell**, for the fragrances of meadows and undergrowth, and of course the aromas of our dishes and wines, so lovely to inhale.
4. Our **touch**, for the possible tactile connection to the grass, leaves, trees and rocks which nature provides or stones which men have carved to build structures.
5. Our **taste**, for the palate, highlighted to taste and appreciate the flavours and finesse of terroir products and cuisine.

The Train Gourmand du Vignoble is an adventure looking to whet and not satiate your appetite.



Meal

You can either bring along your own lunch (all paths have designated picnic areas) or you can eat at one of the Gourmet Vineyard Train's carefully selected restaurants and enjoy a coffee on the house as well as a "special TGV menu" with preferential prices.

Guided Tour

All throughout the trip you will be accompanied by a guide from the Rouffach Historical Society (Société d'Histoire de Rouffach) and the Gueberschwihr-located Kuckuckstei Memory Association (Les Mémoires du Kuckuckstei), who will share their terroir-specific expertise with you, commenting on all the high points of this excursion.

Just for Kids!

PARO and VIC's curiosity book

All throughout the trip, your children will discover lots of things with PARO and VIC.

This book, given to children when the train leaves, is intended to arouse their curiosity and excitement in solving the multiple mysteries along the way.



Wine tasting

The wine tasting aperitif is offered to visitors by the "Pays de Rouffach, Vignobles et Châteaux" Wine-Making Federation of the Community of Municipalities.

It will be focused on discovering great wines from one of the seven terroirs of the Grands Crus: **Zinnkoepflé, Vorbourg, Steinert, Goldert, Hatschbourg, Eichberg, Pfersigberg.**

Along with the wine there will also be kougelhopf, pretzels, and for children, tasting of terroir-produced fruit juices.

This wine tasting is the occasion to offer you a specially-engraved TGV glass... a wonderful souvenir of this discovery day!

There will be a tombola with 3 different prizes for a bottle of Alsace wine. The winners will be given a coupon to present to the selected wine-maker's tasting cellar.

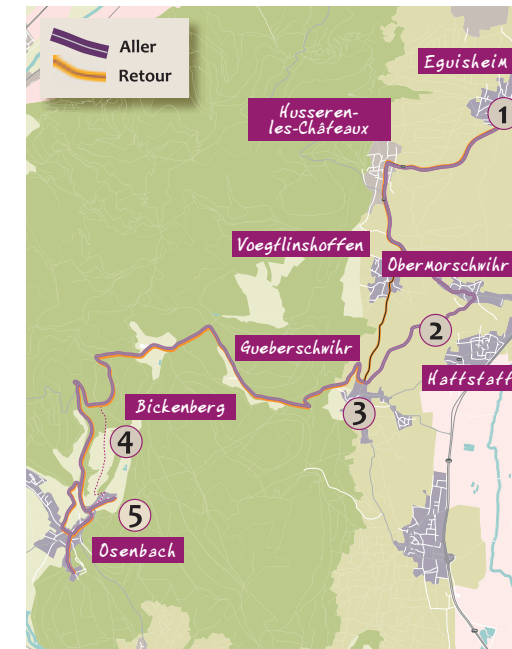
